**RESOLUTION APPROVING SUMMARY LANGUAGE FOR PUBLICATION
OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 300, ZONING ORDINANCE AS IT
RELATES TO ADDING A REVIEW PROCESS FOR ALLOWING EVENT VENUES
AND AGRITOURISM IN SECTION 200:020 DEFINITIONS; 300:032 R-1 DISTRICT;
300:035 R-2 DISTRICT; 300:042 RR DISTRICT; 300:052 AC DISTRICT; 300:0632 RC
DISTRICT; 300:072 C/I DISTRICT; 300:146 EVENT VENUES AND AGRITOURISM;
AND 300:245 SPECIAL EVENTS AND ESTABLISHING PERMIT REQUIREMENTS**

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2020, the Town Board of Princeton Township (the “Town”) adopted Ordinance No. 2020-1, “An Ordinance amending Chapter 300, Zoning Ordinance as it relates to adding a review process for allowing event venues and agritourism in Section 200:020 Definitions; 300:032 R-1 District; 300:035 R-2 District; 300:042 RR District; 300:052 AC District; 300:0632 RC District; 300:072 C/I District; 300:146 Event Venues and Agritourism; and 300:245 Special Events and Establishing Permit Requirements.” (“Ordinance”)

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes, section 365.125, subdivision 2 allows the publication of a summary of an ordinance instead of publishing the whole ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board determines it is impractical to publish the entire text of the Ordinance and that publication of a summary is sufficient to clearly inform the public of the intent and effect of the Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby decides to publish the following summary language, which is hereby approved, in lieu of publishing the full text of the Ordinance:

The Town Board of Princeton Township, Mille Lacs County adopted Ordinance No. 2020-1, on April 21, 2020. The Ordinance provides a review process for allowing event venues and agritourism in certain Zoning Districts of Princeton Township. All event venues and agritourism, which would include farm wineries, distilleries, and microbreweries, would be regulated through a Conditional Use Permit. Definitions of terms related to event venues and agritourism will be added to the list of Definitions in Section 200:020. The R-1 District, R-2 District, the RR District, the C/I District would be amended to include allowances for event venues and agritourism through a Conditional Use Permit. Section 300:146 has been added to provide criteria for review and approval of event venues and agritourism. The Special Event provisions, Section 300:245 was amended to address event venues and agritourism. The full text of the ordinance is available by contacting the Town Clerk and a copy of the ordinance was submitted to the County Law Library and the Princeton Community Library.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to:

- (1) Publish the approved summary language once in the Town's official newspaper;
- (2) Keep a copy of the full Ordinance in the Town Hall and make it available for inspection upon reasonable request;
- (3) Record the full Ordinance in the office of the County Recorder;
- (4) Place a copy of the full Ordinance at the Princeton Community Library;
- (5) Place a copy of the full Ordinance at Mille Lacs County Law Library;
- (6) Provide the County Land Services Office a copy of the full Ordinance; and
- (7) Within 20 days place a copy of the full Ordinance in the Town's Ordinance Book along with a copy of this Resolution and a copy of the affidavit of having published the approved summary language.
