Mr. Stoeckel read the election results:

Supervisor #3: Eugene Stoeckel 144 votes, Joe Gerold 102 votes, Moss 1 vote.

Supervisor #5: Thomas Duden 137 votes, Jim Kusler 93 votes, Greg Anderson 2 votes, Moss 1 vote.

Winners are Eugene Stoeckel and Thomas Duden.

Dan Hiller moved to certify the election results. Seconded by John Wilhelm.
