**RESOLUTION APPROVING SUMMARY LANGUAGE FOR PUBLICATION
OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 700 ZONING ORDINANCE AS IT
RELATES TO NOISE REGULATIONS OF THE PRINCETON TOWNSHIP CODE**

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2025, the Town Board of Princeton Township (the “Town”) adopted Ordinance No. 2025-1, “**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 700 ZONING ORDINANCE AS IT RELATES TO NOISE REGULATIONS OF THE PRINCETON TOWNSHIP CODE.**” (“Ordinance”)

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes, section 365.125, subdivision 2 allows the publication of a summary of an ordinance instead of publishing the whole ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board determines it is impractical to publish the entire text of the Ordinance and that publication of a summary is sufficient to clearly inform the public of the intent and effect of the Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby decides to publish the following summary language, which is hereby approved, in lieu of publishing the full text of the Ordinance:

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 700 ZONING ORDINANCE AS IT
RELATES TO NOISE REGULATIONS OF THE PRINCETON TOWNSHIP CODE**

The Town Board of Princeton Township, Mille Lacs County adopted Ordinance No. 2025-1, on July 15, 2025. The current noise regulation in Section 700:240.3 of the Ordinance is consistent with many township and city regulations for noise, although most jurisdictions will also include reference to Minnesota Administrative rules related to noise limitations throughout the state. The following amendment language is to be added:

The emission of noise by any use shall be in compliance with and regulated by the State of Minnesota Pollution Control Standards, Minnesota Regulation NPC 7030, as may be amended.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to:

- (3) Within 20 days place a copy of the full Ordinance in the Town's Ordinance Book along with a copy of this Resolution and a copy of the affidavit of having published the approved summary language.
