

Princeton Township – Policy for Roadside Clearing of Trees and Brush Less Than 6” in Diameter

It is the policy of the Princeton Town Board to clear brush within the road right-of-way as needed and where feasible. Trees in close proximity to the edge of pavement typically cause heaving and cracking of pavement due to root and trunk growth. Excessive trees, limbs, and brush in the right-of-way may obstruct visibility of street and traffic signs.

Roadside brushing with heavy equipment will be done while the ground is frozen.

Spot roadside brushing of overhanging limbs with hand tools may be done at any time throughout the year as needed.
